# EurTern TRAINING

*EurTern* is designed to provide an up-close look at life and ministry in Europe to those who are seriously exploring missions on the New Dark Continent. *EurTern* will begin June 24 with a week of orientation and training in the town of Algrange, France. During the next

two weeks, participants can either spend one week in each of two of BMW's Europe fields or two weeks on one. The host countries include England, Hungary, Luxembourg, Portugal, Scotland, Spain, and Sweden. Below is the tentative schedule for the week in Algrange:

Participants will enjoy local cuisine and get a glimpse of French life and German history during the week in Algrange. The training will take place at the *Institut biblique et pastoral baptiste*, which is allowing us to use its facilities at a minimal cost to *EurTern*. <https://institutbiblique.eu/english/>

Our guides in Trier are committed Christians who have supplied the following description of our day with them:

“Explore the 2000-plus-year-old city of Trier and trace nearly two millennia of Christianity from Roman palaces to medieval fortresses; from an undercover house church (250 AD) to the splendour of the Baroque; from signs of the first believers in 300 AD to magnificent hand-written Ninth Century Bibles and one of the first Gutenberg Bibles. ”

Weather permitting, we will also be visiting a nearby German village and eating lunch with our guides. The week will also include an evening outing in



the French city of Thionville and a visit to Christian Community Church, an international church in Luxembourg City.

# EurTern **INTERNSHIPS**

## **ENGLAND**

Missionaries can host 1 or 2 interns, either male or female, for two weeks. This church revitalization ministry is in Greater London, and interns will be able to observe and participate in worship services, home or small group gatherings, evangelistic or discipleship Bible studies, men's and/or women's ministry, youth and/or children's ministry, and evangelistic outreach. The stay would include visits to sites of geographical, historical, cultural, or religious significance.

**COST\*** \$60 USD/day



## **PORTUGAL**

Our BMW missionaries, who served for many years in Ireland, are starting house churches and want to build a team in Portugal. They can host three interns, either male or female, for one week. Interns would be able to observe and participate in home or small group gatherings, evangelistic or discipleship Bible studies, evangelistic outreach, and leadership training. The stay would include visits to sites of geographical, historical, cultural, or religious significance.

**COST\*** \$20 USD/day

## **HUNGARY**

Our BMW family are Hungarian, and they have recently started serving in greater Budapest. They can host one intern (either male or female) or a married couple without children, for one week. This is a very new work, so it may not be possible to observe many formal church-related events, the insider exposure to life in Hungary will be invaluable to anyone considering ministry there. Interns will be able to interact with other Hungarians and visit sites of geographical, historical, cultural, or religious significance.

**COST\*** Hosts will provide room and board, but we encourage a generous donation. In addition, an intern should expect to pay \$10 USD per meal when dining out.

## **SPAIN**

Missionaries can host 1 male intern or a married couple without children for one week. An intern could observe and participate in worship services, home or small group gatherings, evangelistic or discipleship Bible studies, leadership training, and more. The internship would include visits to sites of geographical, historical, cultural, or religious significance. A basic knowledge of Spanish is preferred.

**NOTE:** New government regulations will require intern(s) to acquire a letter of invitation from the hosts. Please inquire.

**COST\*** \$40 USD/day

## **LUXEMBOURG**

Christian Community Church is an English-speaking international church in the city of Luxembourg. The church can host 1 intern, either male or female, for two weeks, or 2 interns for one week each. Interns at this established church would be able to observe and participate in home or small group gatherings, evangelistic or discipleship Bible studies, men's and/or women's ministry, and youth and/or children's ministry. The stay would include a visit to sites of geographical, historical, cultural, or religious significance.

**COST\*** \$60 USD/day

# EurTern **REQUIREMENTS**

## **COST\***

Cost for internship each host country includes room, board, and use of laundry equipment if needed. Additional costs are as follows:

1. Training week at <i>Institut biblique et pastoral baptiste</i> :	\$350 USD
2. Incidentals, including entry fees, tour guides and printed matter for Trier excursion:	\$200 USD
3. Cultural Intelligence (CQ Pro) Assessment	\$35 USD
4. Public transportation on field (if required)	\$100 USD
5. Cost share of rented vehicle in Algrange	\$200 USD

**TOTAL\*\*** **\$885 USD**

\*\*The total cost for each intern varies according to the on-field per diem rate and transportation costs to and from the field(s). Interns will be responsible for arranging their own transportation with assistance from the BMW missionaries on the chosen fields. For instance, 14 days in Scotland would cost \$1725 USD (\$60 X 14 + \$885) per intern. In addition, interns will need to acquire adequate travel insurance to cover emergency medical, medical extraction, etc.
